INTRODUCTION

Founded in 2002, Daystar is a not-for-profit pre-K-12 internationally oriented private day school in Beijing. It provides a first-class internationalized curriculum and a balanced Chinese-English bilingual and bicultural education. The school continues to develop and expand, and now has three campuses in Beijing; Beigao (K-12), Sanlitun (pre-K-5) and Quanfa (Early Learning Center) with over 1,000 students. As a bilingual school integrating the Chinese national curriculum system, International Baccalaureate (IB) and Daystar's Social Innovation Program, Daystar pays special attention to character education and cultivates students with a socially innovative mindset, giving them the courage to explore their own path, power to change the world, and confidence to inspire others.

Daystar Academy is fully accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS) and the

Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). It is also a member of the East Asian Regional Council of Schools (EARCOS) and a founding member of the Network for Enriching Schools and Students in China (NESSIC). The school is a fully authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) continuum school offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Diploma Programme (DP).

Attainment data on Measures of Academic Progress (MAP), along with a wide range of external measures, consistently show that students at Daystar Academy make remarkable growth through each year of schooling. In addition, IB Diploma results place Daystar amongst the top schools globally and among the top five schools in Beijing. These sound academic and holistic foundations allow students to pursue further education at the world's most prestigious universities.

OUR STORY

Daystar Academy was founded when Cai Jin-Yong and Dawn Vermilya moved to Beijing from the USA. Chinese-born Jin-Yong, previously CEO of IFC (a member of the World Bank Group and the largest global development institution focused on private sector development and the fight against poverty), and Dawn, his American wife, who also worked for the World Bank, sought a bilingual and bicultural school for their three children. Unable to find a suitable local option to match their vision, the couple launched Daystar Academy in 2002, a school intentionally blending Western and Chinese cultural and educational traditions with a strong focus on character education.

GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

Daystar Academy is a not-for-profit school. It is governed by a parent advisory board on which the Executive Head of Schools sits as an ex officio member.

The Executive Head of Schools has overall responsibility for the day-to-day running of the school across multiple campuses in accordance with the strategic direction of the advisory board. The Executive Principals, in turn, are responsible for the day-to-day running of their respective school divisions.

A COMMUNITY SCHOOL

The engagement of families with Daystar Academy is a vital part of the school's character. Parents buy into the distinctive education that Daystar provides, and this sits at the heart of a constructive and positive relationship between the school and families, which is unusual in China. Many parents are active volunteers in the school. They volunteer in the classrooms and library and at events. There is a parent-run coffee shop on site, the proceeds from which go to charitable causes.





FACILITIES

In line with the not-for-profit nature of the school, significant investment has been made over the past number of years to ensure that the campus facilities are of the highest standards.

Classrooms are spacious and well equipped with touch screen televisions and are well resourced. The school has excellent sports facilities with a full-size artificial soccer pitch, sports dome, tennis courts and baseball batting cages.

The school has also recently completed its canteen renovation and added a new 300 seater multi-purpose performing arts theatre.








LIVING IN BEIJING

Beijing is a dynamic city that has undergone rapid transformation in one generation. It is a modern, international city, a thriving "megacity" with one of the world's busiest airports and a population in excess of 20 million people. There is a growing level of diversity in the city with over 100,000 expatriates calling Beijing home. Certain parts of the city are popular with expatriates – Sanlitun is one such example thanks to its collection of bars, restaurants, shopping and a vibrancy that could rival any international city. Life in the city is fastpaced, and there is little to want for.

Although a modern city, Beijing has a proud history spanning three millennia and is replete with World Heritage sites.

From the Great Wall of China to The Forbidden City and The Temple of Heaven, the city's former – as well as current and future - importance as an economic and political powerhouse is selfevident. Beijing has one of the world's most extensive subway networks, making transport across the city straightforward. The subway is extremely reasonably priced, efficient and constantly expanding. Beijing's air quality has improved significantly. In 2024, Beijing seldom experiences days that are not rated as 'excellent' or 'good' air quality and blue skies over the city are the norm. Daystar monitors the air quality regularly and its air filtration systems ensure that air quality across the school is clean and safe.

Many of China's best international schools are located in Beijing, making it a stimulating place to develop as a school leader. Beijing is a dynamic city and an ideal location for the continued development of an excellent bilingual school with deep roots in the local community.



DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE

The Executive Elementary School Principal (Beigao Campus) will bring experienced administration, acting under the leadership of the Executive Head of Schools. The successful candidate will join an experienced team at a crucial point in the school's development. This new phase will be characterized by a focus on taking the already strong foundations in teaching, learning and other aspects and making them truly world-class.

It is important that the Executive Elementary School Principal is able to embed and further develop policies and practices to facilitate and provide a seamless transition into the middle school. The Executive Elementary School Principal will be a lead figure in terms of ensuring that the positive culture within the school supports the drive for high standards and excellent attainment.

This is a wide-ranging role that requires confident leadership of people, teaching and learning, knowledge of timetabling, curriculum development, finance and excellent stakeholder management. It is a highly visible position that will require a reassuring presence, a sense of self-efficacy and a proactive approach to school development.

The Executive Principal must also be able to

lead and collaborate with a team of Chinese and Western educators within the elementary division and beyond, ensuring that teachers and staff have the support they need to implement Daystar's unique Elementary bilingual program.

Moreover, in the competitive Beijing market, this role will make an important contribution in terms of ensuring that the school's unique characteristics that differentiate Daystar from other private and international schools are understood by the wider school, parental and prospective parental communities

- Experience in keeping abreast of and judiciously implementing – researchinformed best practice
- Ability to lead effective curriculum reviews and development
- Ability to ensure the Chinese National Curriculum is being implemented
- Ability to lead teachers in implementing instruction using inquiry-based learning and best practices
